

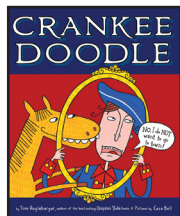

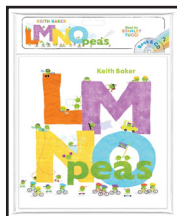

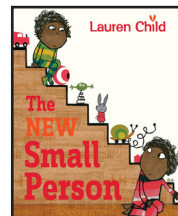
Crankee Doodle By Tom Angleberger

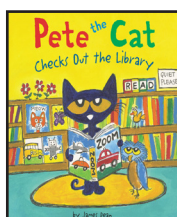
The New Small Person By Lauren Child

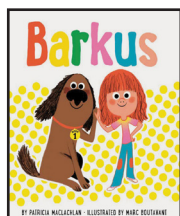
Pete the Cat Checks Out the Library By James Dean

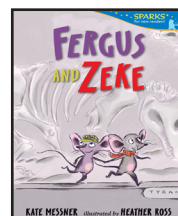
Barkus By Patricia MacLachlan

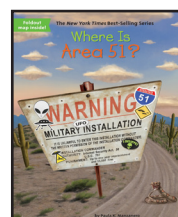
The Poet's Dog By Patricia MacLachlan

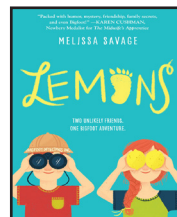
Amulet 8 Supernova By Kazu Kibuishi

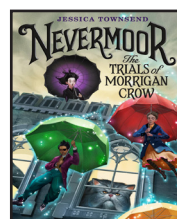
Me and Marvin Gardens By Amy Sarig King

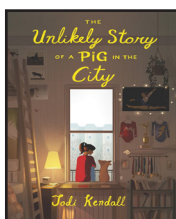
Nevermoor 1 Trials of Morrigan Crow By Jessica Townsend

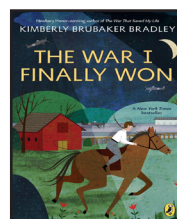
See You in Cosmos By Jack Cheng
