

From alligators all around to zippity zound, from entertaining elephants to throwing tantrums, the antics of these alligators have made reciting the alphabet fun


for over fifty years. In this larger, 5 x 7 trim size, *Alligators All Around* will continue to make children giggle while learning their ABCs. \$7.95



Baby Shark By John John Bajet


Children will delight in this silly sing-along story with funny, eye-popping illustrations and informative picture guides to help readers mimic and

The Bear Ate Your Sandwich By Julia Sarccone-Roach



It is time for bed for Mr. Panda and his friends. Fortunately for them, Mr. Panda is there to remind


them that they've each forgotten to do something, like taking a bath or brushing their teeth. But even Mr. Panda can make a bedtime mistake! \$6.99

Frog wants to be anything but a slimy, wet frog. A cat, perhaps. Or a rabbit. An owl! But when a hungry wolf arrives, our hero decides


that being himself isn't so bad after all. \$7.99

Despite fierce prejudice and abuse, Fannie Lou Hamer was a champion of civil rights.



Kitty's life is really hard. And when she accidentally gets bonked on the head, she starts to believe she's a dog. This new dynamic freaks out



Is Dog Man bad to the bone? The heroic hound is sent to the pound for a crime he didn't commit! While his pals work to prove his innocence, Dog Man


struggles to find his place among dogs and people. Being a part of both worlds, will he ever fully fit in with one? \$9.99

Dory has her first loose tooth, and with her usual over-the-top excitement, she cannot stop talking about the tooth fairy. Naturally, this drives her



Morgan the librarian gives Jack and Annie magical baseball caps and sends them to a special ballgame in Brooklyn, New York, in 1947! When they




Black Panther Young Prince


Checked


Ellie's Story


Endling 1 The Last


Moon Base Alpha 3 Waste of Space
